

Your preschoolers don't necessarily need to have any Chinese background before participating in this program. By using My First Chinese Words, the young learners will be exposed to the sounds, the Characters, and some basic conversations that occur in our daily lives. Interactive teaching aids such as flash cards, CDs of Chinese songs and videos will also be frequently used in class.

We always assign TAs to our pre-K classes, plus some parents stay in the class during lecture time, so the adult-kid ratio is low. By the end of the school year, the kids should be able to say their names in Mandarin, recognize their names written in Chinese Characters, and understand the meanings of (or be able to respond to) some simple sentences spoken in Mandarin.





What's even better is that the kids have their own dedicated playground to have fun at during recess time. We believe this is one of the best Pre-K Chinese Learning programs you can find in San Diego area!
